

Sage BusinessVision 2015 (v7.73A)

This Sage BusinessVision 2015 update can only be applied to Sage BusinessVision 2014. The installation of Sage BusinessVision 2015 is similar to the installation of a Sage BusinessVision service pack. Sage BusinessVision 2014 (7.7) must be installed prior to installing Sage BusinessVision 2015 (7.73A).

If you are not running Sage BusinessVision 2014 and wish to update to Sage BusinessVision 2015, you must first update your Sage BusinessVision to version 2014 and then apply this update to upgrade to version 2015.

What's new

Changes in this release:

- The Purchase Order module did not remove serial numbers that were returned when a different user had received them.
- The Order Entry module created payment history records for foreign currency transactions that raised unnecessary error messages in the Data Validation utility.
- Using the Import utility to modify the Alternate field for existing inventory items resulted in a "File Access Error 10" message.
- Using the Import utility to import inventory extended descriptions caused unnecessary prompts to save changes when paging through the inventory file.
- Using the Import utility to import customers results in the customer name being written to the Name field in the Address file, in addition to the customer file.
- The Recurring Journal Entry utility could not be accessed by users with priority levels less than 9.
- Using the Order File Import utility to import an order that contained a kitted inventory item which had a negative on-hand quantity resulted in an incorrect backorder calculation.
- The Comparative Performance Report did not display values from the correct period when the report was run for a fiscal period in last fiscal year for non-calendar fiscal years. (No report change was required).
- The "Detailed Aged AP - by name" report did not display the vendor phone number. (The "Detailed Aged AP - by name.rpt" report was changed to address this issue).
